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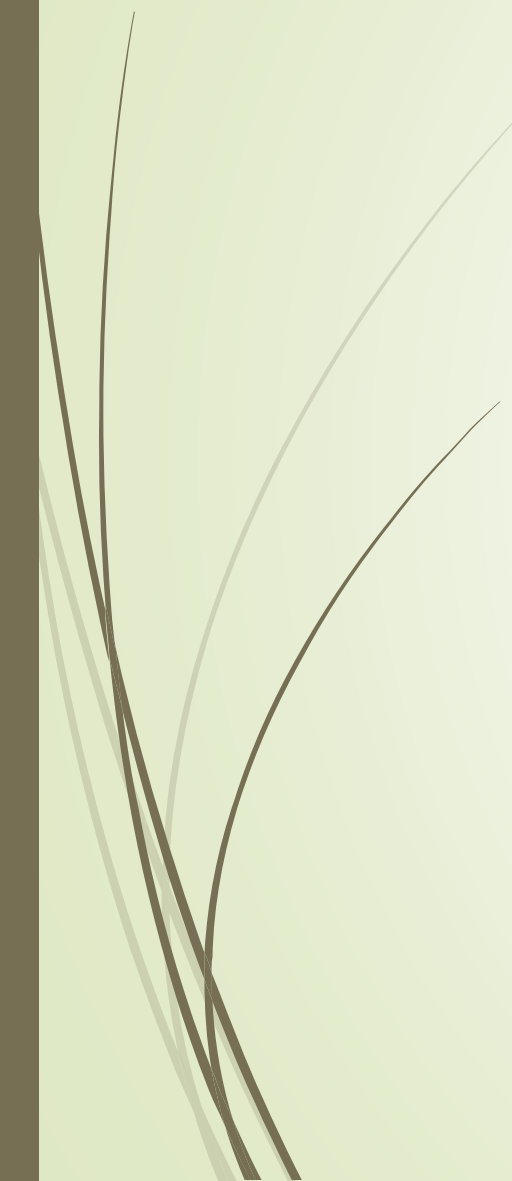
The Significance of Adult Education

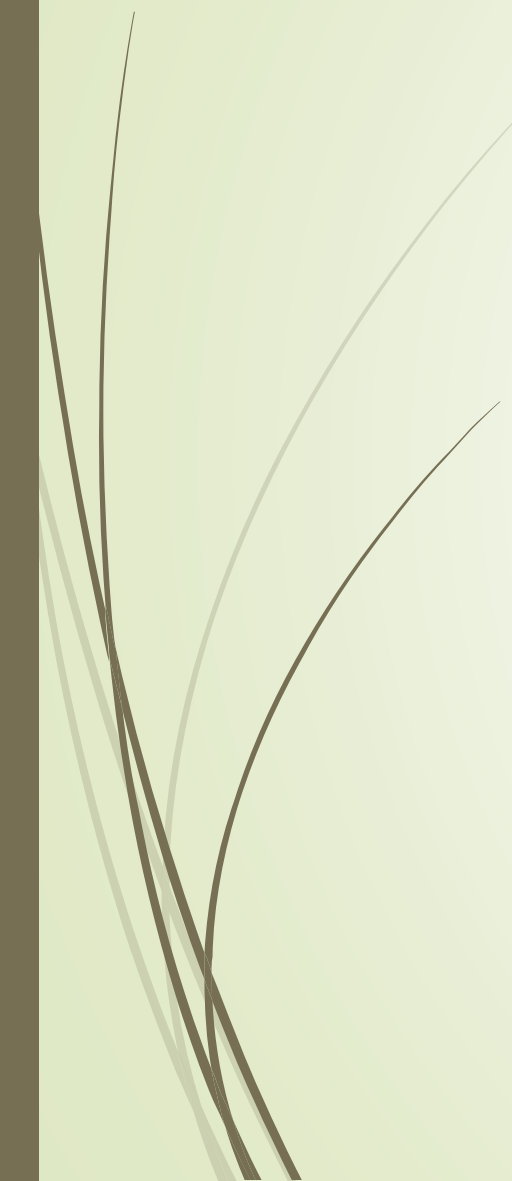
Innovation and Accessibility as Core Principles

Creating Empowering Learning Environments

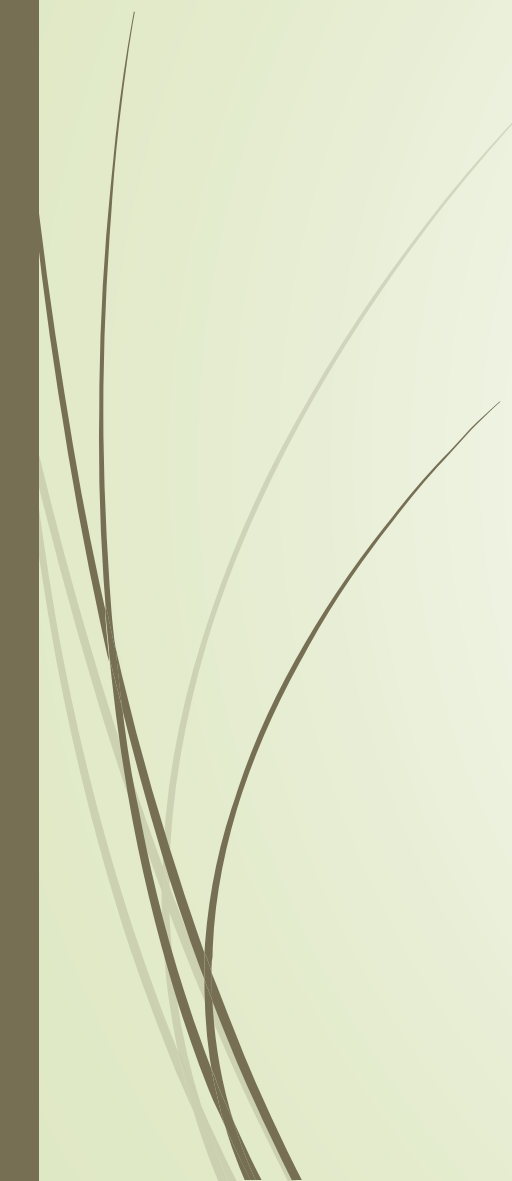

The Shift Toward Transformative Learning

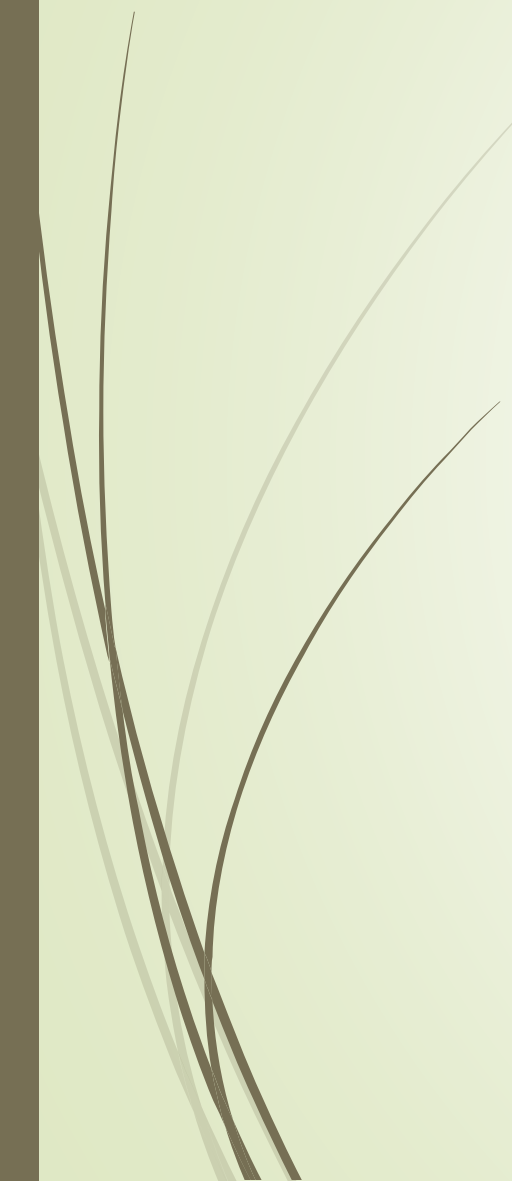

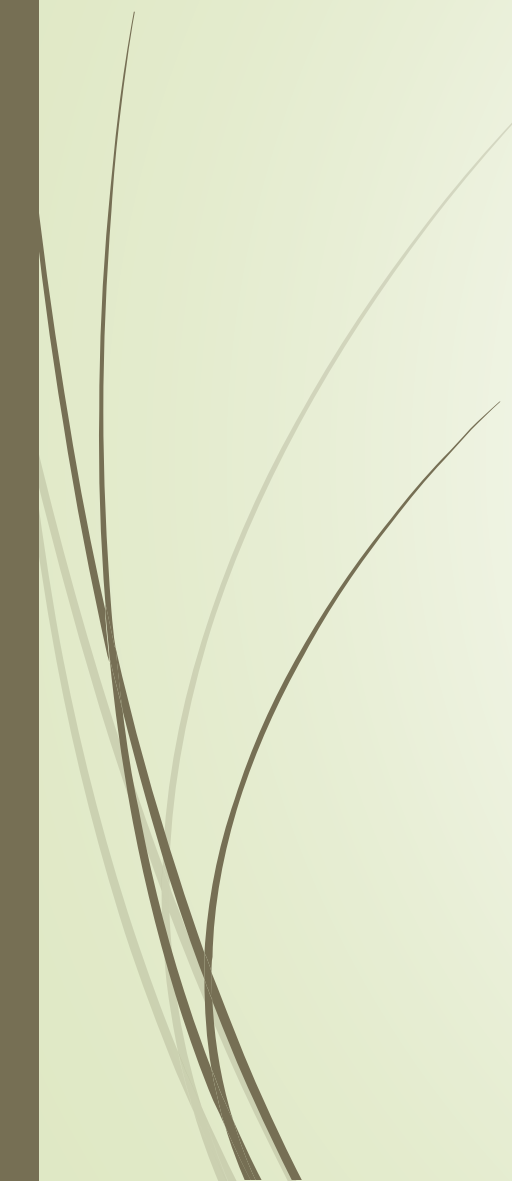
Inclusion as a Way of Life

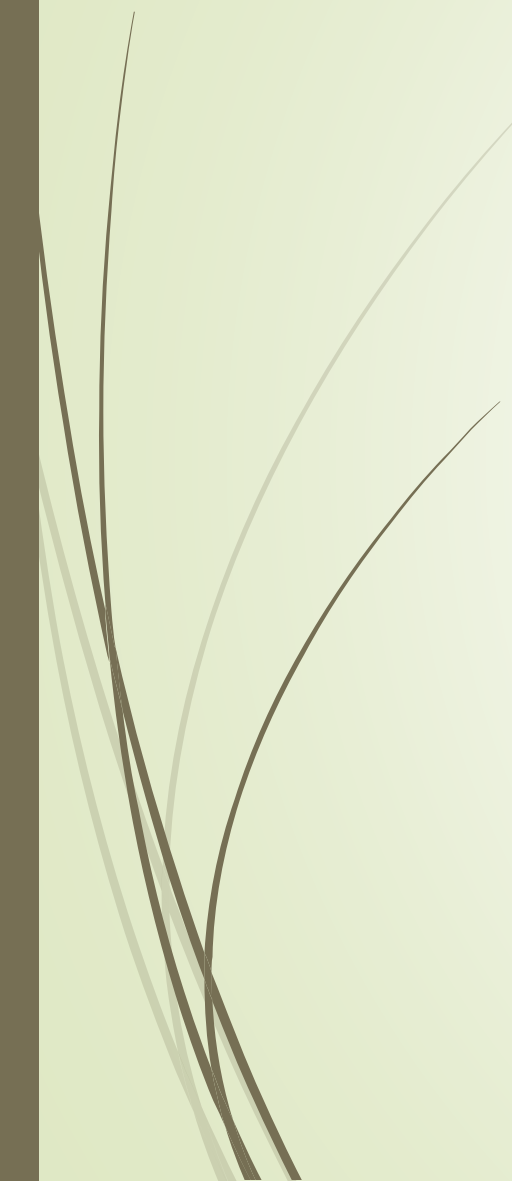


Universal Design and Technology Integration

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Participatory Methodologies in Practice

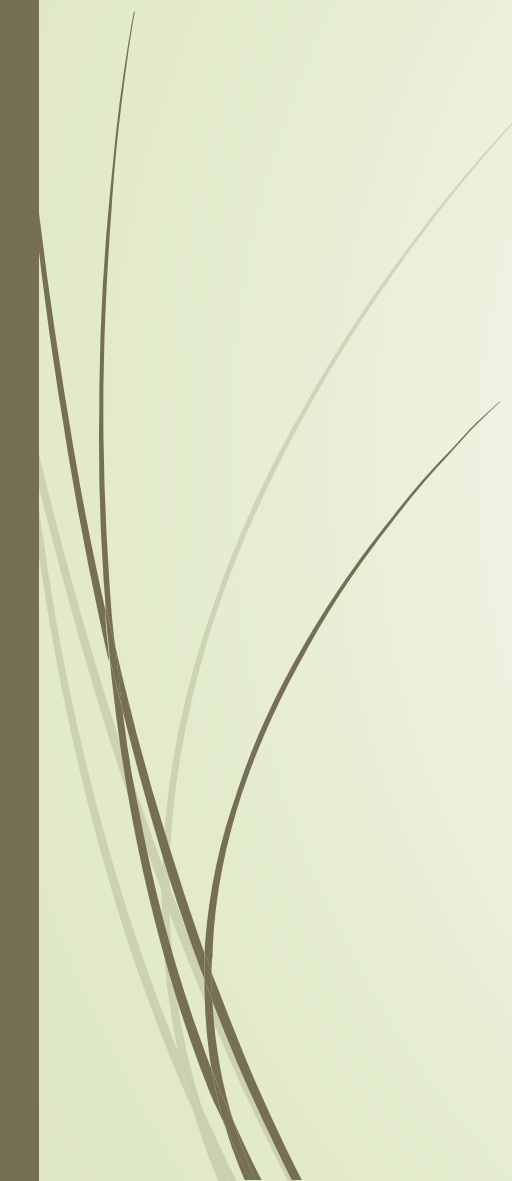

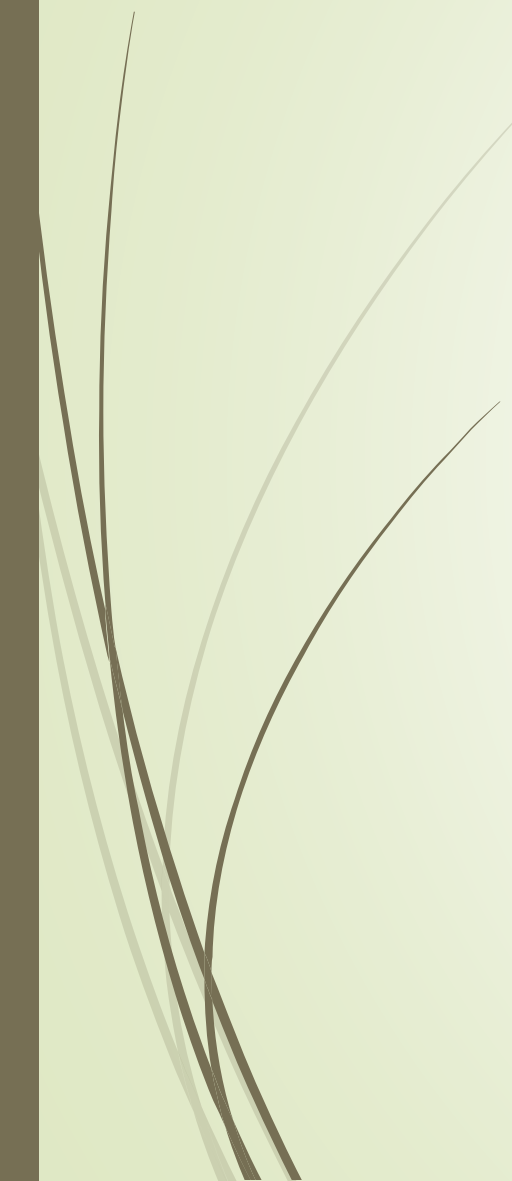
Professional Development and Sustainable Practices

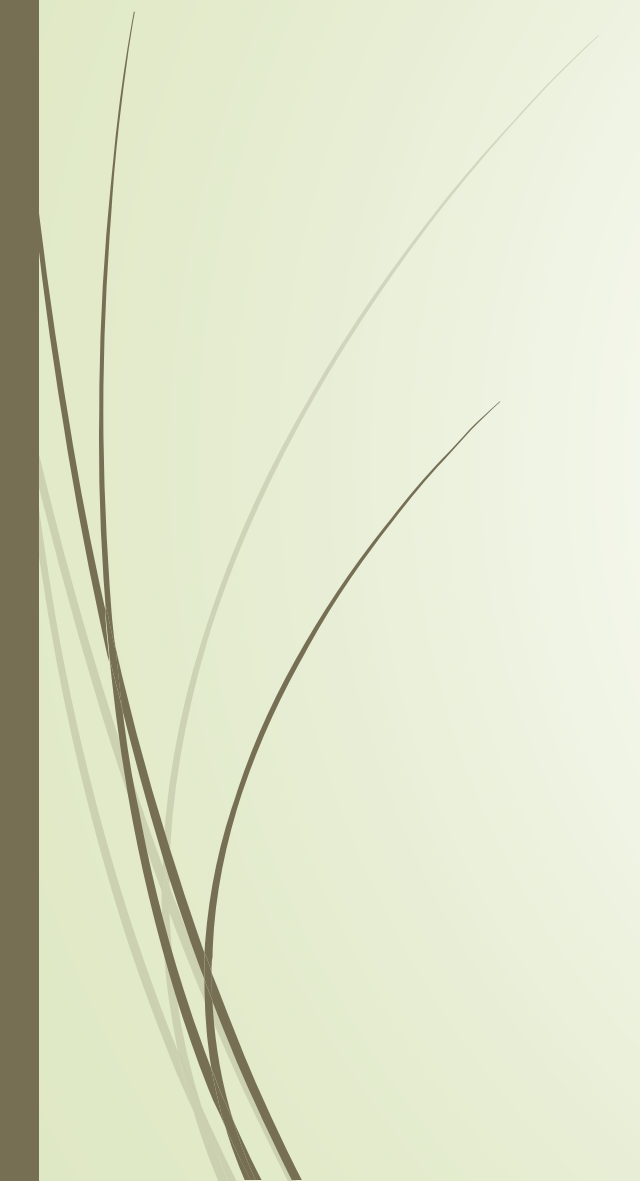




Evaluation and the Vision of Inclusive Societies
